Order from the walk-up window and enjoy your pint in the beer garden around back. The menu features hearty top-notch pub fare prepared with flair. No TVs. Just good beer, good food, and conversation.





3 The Corner Pub

The Corner Pub appreciates fine craft beers and proudly serves a rotating variety, with a preference for Decatur and Atlanta area breweries. The Pub happily pours and serves other craft beers from around the world, as well as old-school standbys re-popularized by hipsters. This is a true neighborhood bar, with great food, a friendly wait staff, and engaging regulars.

4 The Imperial

This Oakhurst neighborhood favorite in a converted 1920s service station features a rotating list of Georgia craft beers and buzzworthy brews from across the nation. The menu offers pub fare — burgers, hot dogs, sandwiches and fried delights — and interesting salads and appetizers. Renovation of the space revealed painted advertising on what used to be an exterior brick wall. Give it a look.





5 Inner Voice Brewing

Established by two industry veterans, Inner Voice Brewing focuses on brewing finely tuned contemporary styles. Expect to see an extensive tap list of hazy IPAs, stouts and fruited sours, along with quaffable lagers and saisons. Inner Voice is home to a colorful, eclectic taproom that is inviting to all. Food vendor onsite, too.

6 Leon's Full Service

The adventurous kitchen and the innovative bar at Leon's work hand-in-hand to create an exceptional dining and drinking experience. For beer lovers, the bar features 14 rotating taps with rich European brews and some noteworthy American craft beers. Ask your server to help pair up your beer with your meal (or vice versa). And enjoy a cocktail before dinner – the bar specializes in the classics and in its own signature libations.

A true Irish pub on the square in Decatur, O'Sullivan's features the most sought-after brews of Ireland and the UK, along with a few American staples. The real emphasis here is on spirits – 30 different Irish whiskeys, more than 50 varieties of Scotch, and another three dozen North American whiskeys. Outstanding Irish pub fare as well.

Georgia's first Craft Malt certified brewpub (using 100 percent local malt) offers American style beers to-go or on draft, local spirits, and food from various chef pop-ups. Utilizing local products as often as possible, Sceptre creates unique beers with Southern flavor. The sprawling beer garden and patio is open year-round with a projector and several screens for watching sports and films.

Steinbeck's Ale House emulates the comfortable trattorias of the Italian countryside, where chefs prepare daily specials using fresh ingredients acquired at their peak. The draft brew selection here includes American craft beers but the focus is on rich and flavorful exotic European offerings that pair well with adventurous kitchen specials.

Bread is from Holeman & Finch, and desserts from Southern Sweets.

Families welcome until 9 o'clock, but adults only after that.
